If you are interested and apply to work at the café you can expect the following

- 1) An initial assessment to help you and ourselves decide if the café is the right place for you at this time, to look at what aspects of the industry you might want to train in and to draw up a vocational profile that will help you when you are thinking about work. To agree how many days a week you would like to train. The café is open 7 days per week, but no person works more than 5 days.
- 2) If the café is the right place for you, to agree what qualifications you wish to consider. We provide a range including (but not limited to): Food Safety in Catering, Moving and Handling, Entry level Certificate in Catering 1, Entry Level Certificate in Food Studies 2, Entry Level Certificate in Hospitality in Catering 3.
- 3) Support to progress through the qualifications and to construct a work record and history, whilst obtaining practical experience working in the café which is open to and serving the public.
- 4) When you are reaching the end of your training, support to consider your next step. Is it for further specialised training away from the café, or is it to look for employment?
- 5) If you are looking for employment, support from an experienced employment worker (using the IPS model) to apply for work, support with interviews and once obtained support to help you make a success of this.
